

How to plan your trip

1. Start by reviewing bus schedules and maps.

Individual route schedules and maps are available at the Metro Bus display at Atwood, on all buses, at the Metro Bus Transit Center, or online at ridemetrobus.com. You can view the system route map display in Atwood or online at ridemetrobus.com.

2. Find the route closest to the starting point of your trip,

then locate the route closest to your destination and determine what time you want to arrive there. If your starting point and destination aren't on the same route, you may need to transfer to a different route that goes to your destination.

3. Transfers may be made at any point along a bus route.

Major transfer hubs include the Metro Bus Transit Center, and Crossroads Shopping Center. To determine your transfer time, match the timepoint location on your first route schedule to the same location on your second route schedule. It may be necessary to wait up to 45 minutes for a connecting route.

Instructions for popular destinations

SCSU to Crossroads Mall (and back)

See individual schedules for exact times.

1. From Miller LRC, catch the **11 University** bus. Ride it to the Metro Bus Transit Center, downtown.
2. From the Transit Center, hop on the **1 Waite Park** bus. Ride it to Crossroads Mall.
3. After shopping, walk back to the Crossroads Mall shelter marked for the Pantown route, and take the **2 Pantown** bus back to the Transit Center.
4. From the Transit Center, ride the **11 University** bus to the SCSU bus stop located on 7th St. and 5th Ave, across from Miller Center.

SCSU to Walmart (and back)

See individual schedules for exact times.

1. From Miller Center, catch the **11 University** Bus. Ride it to the Metro Bus Transit Center, downtown.
2. From the Transit Center, hop on the **31 Sartell** bus. Ride it to Walmart. It is good to note that the bus goes to Walmart on its way to Sartell, as well as its way back to downtown St. Cloud.
4. After shopping, take the **31 Sartell** bus to the Transit Center.
4. From the Transit Center, ride the **11 University** bus to the SCSU bus stop located on 7th St. and 5th Ave, across from Miller Center.

Other useful information

- Be at the bus stop **five minutes early** to avoid missing the bus.
- Step out of the shelter as the bus approaches so the driver can see you.
- Have your ID/Pass ready **BEFORE** boarding the bus.
- Check the route name displayed on its marquee (located on the side of bus above the window next to the door) to be sure it's the bus you want. Several different bus routes may travel down the same street.
- Pull the yellow cord located near the windows to indicate that you want the bus to stop at the next bus stop.
- Routes 81-85 (the Campus Clippers), 91/92 Husky Shuttle, 93 Sundowner & 94/95 Late Nite routes only run when SCSU is in session.
- Route maps and schedules are available online, on the buses, at the Transit Center and on campus in Atwood.
